MILESTONES

- 1979:** Founded by a youth group at Grace Lutheran Church in Glen Ellyn.
- 2023:** Moved to 55 N. Park Blvd., a 100-year-old house on the campus of Faith Lutheran Church in Glen Ellyn.
- 2024:** Changed name to Glen House Food Pantry, reflecting Glen Ellyn roots and location in renovated house.
